**Meeting Location:** Redfield Auditorium, 45 Water St., Woods Hole, MA

**Airport Transfer**

There are two bus lines that travel between Boston Logan Airport and Woods Hole. Websites for Peter Pan Bus and Plymouth and Brockton Bus are below. Travel on these from Logan Airport is easy and not expensive, with service to Falmouth and Woods Hole. Note: Anyone staying at Inn on the Square should take the bus to the Falmouth stop, a short walk to the hotel, and anyone at Sands of Time should take the Wood Hole stop, a 5-minute walk to the hotel. Tickets must be booked online.

**Meeting Shuttle Service**

WHOI is providing meeting shuttle service to/from Inn on the Square and Sands of Time with White Tie Limo service. The shuttle service will also be transporting meeting attendees from the village to the evening events on our Quissett campus and back to the hotels after the events conclude.

**Morning Shuttle Times:**

Inn on the Square – Shuttle bus will arrive at 7:15 am and leave promptly at 7:30 am

Sands of Time – Shuttle bus will arrive around 7:35 am and leave promptly at 7:45 am

Note: the bus will be located at the bottom of the driveway at Sands of Time

## **Parking**

- We strongly suggest carpooling or taking the shuttle, if you have the opportunity, as parking space is limited in the Woods Hole village.
- Please park in the Shiverick Parking lot on School Street. Redfield is directly across the street from this parking lot. It will be marked WHOI Employees Only, but you may park there. If full (unlikely at 8 am), please refer to the attached map for other parking lot locations.
- Park and proceed to Redfield to register and you will be issued a parking pass for the duration of the meeting dates. You must return to your vehicle to place this pass on your dashboard.
