## About The Royal Armoury (Livrustkammaren)

This is Sweden's oldest museum and located in the Royal Palace, with its entrance at the beginning of Slottsbacken from Skeppsbron. It houses ceremonial armors, weapons, and garments from Sweden's royal history dating back to the early 1600s.

Here, you can see Gustav III's masquerade costume, still bearing the hole from the fatal shot, and Charles XII's blue coat, with mud still clinging to it from when he fell in the trench after being shot.
